## **GENERAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

## Candidates for a degree from Muhlenberg College must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. Candidates must earn no fewer than 34 course units, at least 17 of them in courses offered through Muhlenberg.
- 2. Candidates must satisfy all general academic requirements.
- 3. Candidates must satisfy the Physical Education Requirement, normally through PED 050.
- 4. Candidates must be certified in a major field of study. Normally, at least half of the courses required for a major must be Muhlenberg courses.
- 5. Candidates must earn a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.00, based on the total number of Muhlenberg College course units attempted.
- 6. Candidates must earn a grade point average in the major field of study of not less than 2.00, based on the total number of course units attempted in the major.
- 7. Candidates must normally complete their final two semesters "in residence." A student is considered "in residence" when enrolled for 3 or more course units at Muhlenberg during a traditional academic (fall or spring) semester. This regulation does not apply to students who have been accepted to degree candidacy through the Wescoe School at Muhlenberg College.
- 8. Candidates must attend Commencement unless excused by the Office of the Registrar.
